The TRY HARDER CUP is the Be The Ball Tour's very own Ryder Cup style event.

Throughout each season, the BTB Members of that particular year are drafted into 4 teams - Shooters, Crocs, Cattledogs and King Browns. Each team has a designated captain whose job it is to select those players they believe will create a team worthy of being the BTB Try Harder Cup team of the year.

When the tour began in 2009, there were 3 essential areas where our members came from. Southern Division (Sydney and surrounds), Western Division (Dubbo and surrounds) and Northern Division (Tamworth and surrounds).

Over the years these teams evolved into the Shooters and the Crocs, who from BTB5 Cairns, fought out an official teams comp. For the first 6 official seasons the Crocs were unbeaten, and the Shooters could not by a trick.

Come BT11, under the captaincy of Gearyous Stuff, the Shooters finally managed to beat their archrivals, the Crocs. It was 7th time lucky for Gearyous Stuff, and he promptly retired from the captaincy after scaling his own Everest.

Cryan Out Loud took over the reins for BTB12, with no tour being finalised due to Covid19. In BTB13 though, Cryan Out Loud guided the Shooters to their second ever victory.

In BTB10, our first major anniversary season, two new teams were voted on by members and created a 4-team competition . The Cattledogs and King Browns made their entrance onto the BTB stage, under the guidance of Lonhro Leba (Cattledogs) and Saving Private (King Browns). Neither team has won the Try Harder Cup as at BTB13.

The Try Harder Cup is fought over a number of events. These include Group 3 Tattoo Trophy events; Group 2 BTB events and pinnacle Tattoo Trophy events and the coveted Group 1 BTB 'Pillar Trophy' events. (*You can see the rules and scoring by clicking on the blue tabs above).

To the winners go the spoils. BTB13 saw 'The Champions Table' introduced. Each season at the tour's 'Closing Ceremony Chinese Meal' the champion THC team for that year sit together at the Champions Table, where they regale themselves with winning stories and how they are the kings of the BTB world.

The other 3 losing teams members all need to pay \$20 each towards the Champions Table, in effect paying for their well-earned winners. For every winner grinning there needs to be a loser feeling a little pain!

The CROCS were one of the 2 original teams formed in BTB5 to compete annually in the team's events of the BTB season and tour. In the early years of the tour, teams were originally split into Western, Southern & Northern Divisions.

In BTB3 #26 Comelateronstie designed the original Croc logo (on right). He included a beer, golf club & country origin rugby league jersey. He was awarded that seasons Big Marn of the Year award. In BTB10 (our anniversary season), the new look Crocs logo (on the left) was unveiled to celebrate the occasion. The late, great Crocodile Hunter Steve Irwin their chief patron.






The SHOOTERS were one of the 2 original teams formed in BTB5 to compete annually in the team's events of the BTB season and tour. In BTB3 #1 Craig's Carnival designed the original Shooters logo (on right). He included a golf ball gun, golf clubs, tees on an ammo belt & city skyline. The great irony is that Craig's Carnival was not chosen as a 'franchise player' by then Shooters captain Gearyous Stuff in the first player draft & was swiftly snapped up by the Crocs! The WRANGLERS were introduced to the competition in BTB15 – another anniversary season of significance.

As always, the first Wranglers season was filled with many challenges, but the team fought hard in every competition, building their culture and laying the foundation stones for the Wrangler legends to follow. How the teams are selected...

The Be The Ball Tour is an invitation only annual season competition and golf event.

After every annual June Long Weekend Tour, if slots are available within the tour, members can nominate new members to join the tour.

In the second half of June, the final field for that season's competition is completed and announced.

The team captains are then allowed to draft a nominated number of existing 'franchise' players from their current team, who they are allowed to retain for the upcoming season.

In the first week of July each year, a 'Marquee' draft is then completed and revealed where each captain has drafted their main 'guns' in order.

Those players not selected as a marquee/franchise player then enter a free agent player draft, along with any new members. This is also conducted in the first week of July.

Captains are allowed to trade, negotiate and ultimately select their teams to play against each other.

From this point the teams compete each other over the year for the THC (Try Harder Cup) Premiership.



The **TRY HARDER CUP** wasn't officially born until BTB10. Before that time, the competition went through different phases of team competitions. True competition began in the BTB5 Cairns season.

In the early years, most Be The Ballers came from Sydney, Western NSW (Dubbo & surrounds) and Northern NSW (Tamworth & surrounds). Therefore, the natural decision was to create Southern Division, Western Division and Northern Division teams.

Drawing on our combined love and support of rugby league, the colours of the teams from the annual City v Country rugby league fixtures were used. Yellow and blue for Southern Division and Maroon and Gold for Country. Northern Division were obviously under the country NSW fold but needed different colours. Traditionally black and gold, it was decided that we already had enough yellow/gold, so Northern Division became predominantly red within the BTB.
