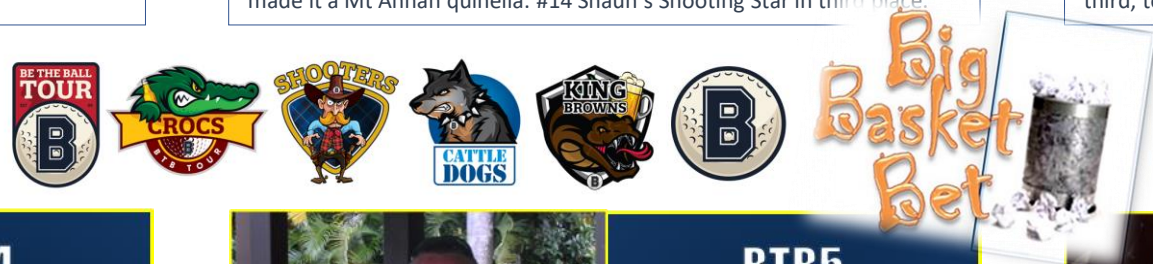
**BTB5
